About us

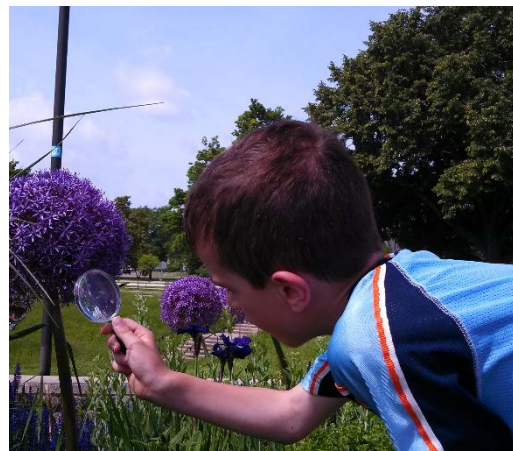
The Conservatory provides visitors a horticultural showcase that changes floral material 5 times a year, a tropical and desert ecosystem design set as naturally as possible. Other offerings include events, protection of certain rare and endangered floral species on display in the desert and tropical dome as well as horticultural information and workshops.

The Education Center offers programming for grades K5-12, college, adults, companies, homeschoolers, travel agencies, all youth groups and individual workshop and guided group tour offerings throughout the year.

School Groups: \$6/student

All classes with the educator are handicap accessible. Preregistration is required at: county.milwaukee.gov/ContactTheDomesEducator

- Submit e-form 3 weeks in advance
- Receive email confirmation and invoice
- Send payment in 10 days prior to visit
- Receive all worksheets; copy and distribute along with field trip rules

Adult Groups: \$8/person

Adult guide tours and classes are handicap accessible and include time in the domes as part of the educational program.

- Prepay 10 days prior to visit
