## POSITION DESCRIPTION: Adjunct Interpretive Educator

Position Summary: The Friends of the Domes' Adjunct Interpretive Educator will substitute for Education Program staff members on an on-call, as-needed basis.

Position Type: On-call

**Start Date:** As soon as April 10, 2023

**Reports to:** Education Director

**Location:** Mitchell Park Horticultural Conservatory (Milwaukee, WI)

Compensation: \$25/hour. Hours per week will vary

## Schedule:

On-call, as-needed basis during typical school hours: Weekdays 8:30AM-3PM, most often 8:30-11:30AM. Some weekend hours and additional duties may be added. Adjunct Educator will serve as a substitute staff member for education program staff members. Includes hours for shadowing current educators and learning provided curriculum. Will be notified with as much advance warning as possible.

## Responsibilities:

Adjunct Educators are primarily responsible for performing field trip duties and program instruction in the Education Center or other settings (such as online formats).

Lead Interpretive Educator Duties: Educators follow a provided curriculum to educate students about The Domes and its plant collection. Field trips take place during school hours (9AM-2:30PM), for 10-70 students and adults. Each field trip requires program material setup and takedown.

Education Director Duties: Responsible for the safety, behavior management, emergency procedures, and logistics during field trips at The Domes.

Availability on an on-call, as-needed basis during typical school field trip times; applications will
not be considered if applicant does not have daytime availability

- Ability to learn and teach educational programs (shadowing current staff available)
- Comfort in speaking in public to large groups of children and adults
- Comfort teaching inside the desert, tropical and show domes
- Time management skills
- Friendly, personable
- Some computer skills: email, typing, editing, Google platform (Docs, Sheets, Meets)
- Strong commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion
- Ability to lift up to 40 lbs.
- Optional: Bilingual (Spanish/English) preferred
- Some experience:

  - Working with children
  - Horticulture, science, plants, nature, sustainability, health and wellness
  - Working in the nonprofit sector
